



VD11NR 2010 Statistics*


The goal for D11NR for 2010 is 10,000 VSC's. We are 100% of our goal for the year with 10,035 VSC's and 103% of 2009 production! The data source is AUXINFO. PLEASE be certain that all stats are reported MONTHLY using the CURRENT Form 7038 to your FSO-IS so you and your unit(s) will receive proper credit. Additional stats from AUXINFO* indicates that 5,736 or 57% of our VSC's are First Time VSC's. In addition 6,615 or 66% are High Risk VSC's.
